


The celebration continues throughout the night. In the north of Sweden, the sun continues to shine and never completely disappears behind the horizon.







SWEDISH ARCHIPELAGO

This is where Swedish people prefer to spend their summers.


Equipped with their picnic baskets

In the book, Nils experiences the many wonders Sweden has to offer, whilst slowly transforming into a kind boy.





Natural light plays a vital part in Swedish interior design. In combination with an airy space and minimalistic colour palette, this styling embraces a "less is more" mentality.






